

PEKUDEI - Accounts - פְּקוּדֵי



Exodus 38:21 - 40:38

*Kol sof hu hatchalah chadasha!**Kol ha'kavod! כל הכבוד* Well done! All honor to you!

You have persevered and completed this beginner's course of Hebrew Bytes: *Yvrit Le'at Le'at*. It is a *sof*, ending, but hopefully also a *hatchalah*, a beginning, as you go forward and find ways to use and improve your Hebrew.

***Note**: we will have a Hebrew Bytes 24 as a Revision of the course and for further suggestions and recommendations.

The *parasha Pekudei* - פְּקוּדֵי - brings us to the conclusion of the second book of the Torah - *Shemot* / Exodus and we can, therefore, say a hearty **Chazak, chazak, ve'nitchazek!** **Be strong, be strong, and let us strengthen one another!** חזק חזק ונתחזק!

The title word, *Pekudei*, means accounts or inventory. In modern Hebrew a *pakid*, פְּקִיד from the same root, **peh-kuf-dalet**, means a teller in a bank. In any form of accounting, attention to details is vital. In these chapters on the Tabernacle we understand that details also are important in the economy of God! It's a reminder to us to be good stewards of all the Lord gives into our hands, materially and spiritually. This applies especially to our life itself - for which we will need to give an account when we return it to Him.

We read in the *parashah* that *Bnei Israel* - בְּנֵי יִשְׂרָאֵל - the children of Israel did *all* according to *all* that the Lord had commanded Moshe. What was the result? And Moshe blessed them! *Yevarech otam Moshe*. בֵּרַךְ אֹתָם מֹשֶׁה!
In 40:34 we read that when Moshe finished the work, the cloud covered the Tabernacle and the glory of the Lord filled the Tabernacle! *Ve'kavod Adonai maleh et ha'Mishkan*.
